



Rhyming Words Game Ideas Letter Families -at, -og, and -ug.

Rhyme Toss: Label three containers. One with -at, one with -og, and one with -ug. Get some cotton balls or bean bags. Show the rhyming word flash card and ask your child to toss the cotton ball into the correct container.



Stand-Up and Sit Down game: Say two words or show two flash cards. If the words rhyme then stand up. If they don't, sit down. Example, Bat and Cat Stand Up. Bat and Dog. Sit down.



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
